Cost?

Items to pack:

- Toiletries (shampoo, soap, hair dryer, etc.)
- Bedding/blankets/sleeping bag (twin bed provided)
- Towels
- Swimsuit and water shoes (required to go in lake)
- Me-in-a-Box (3-5 items about self)
- Official Dress
- Casual Official Dress or dress shirt/polo and dress pants/khakis
- Clothes for service project including close-toed shoes
- Appropriate clothing:
 - Shorts longer than fingertips
 - Tank tops with straps at least 3 fingers wide
 - Light jacket or sweatshirt recommended for cooler mornings/evenings
- Extra cash for snacks
 - Food/gum/beverages are NOT allowed in cabins
- Water bottle
- Needed medications
